NEW VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITY - WORSHIP TECH

While this new season in our world has presented many and various challenges, it has also afforded our congregation the opportunity to provide online worship resources for those who are unable to physically gather in our building. We are thankful that we have been blessed with the means to build out a system that allows us to stream our worship services, and we are now looking for volunteers to help sustain this new aspect of our ministry. A brief overview of the position can be found below. The purpose of this position is to facilitate the audio and visual systems for Sunday morning worship for those gathering in person and online. The monthly commitment would be one Sunday Morning each month, from 7 am – 9:30 am. An additional hour-long training to be scheduled any time + 1 Sunday morning from 10 am – 12 pm

GLOCAL MISSIONARY TRAINING SCHOOL

You are invited to attend a 15-week online class that begins August 25. It meets Tuesday evenings from 6-8pm. Learn how to become an everyday missionary. Pastor David Kim of Glocal Mission is the lead trainer. Pastor Steve Nickodemus and Pastor Langdon Reinke are facilitators. Cost is \$200/person (not including Short-Term Mission Trip expenses). HERE IS WHAT TO EXPECT FOR IN-PERSON WORSHIP

- **LIMITED CAPACITY.** Under Phase 2 and 3 we are allowed **no more than 50 people** at each service.
- **RSVP for ATTENDANCE.** Please let us know what worship service you are planning to attend. RSVP on our website. For those without electronic capability, please call the office and let us know. Thank you!
- **MASKS.** Please **bring and wear** your own mask while you are indoors. Masks will be provided at the door for those who do not have one.
- **PHYSICAL DISTANCING.** Please keep a **6-10 foot** physical distance from others at all times.
- **SEATING.** Ushers will seat people by family or household groups.
- **DISTRIBUTION OF COMMUNION.** Ushers will direct each family to come forward to receive Holy Communion in a processional manner (not by tables).

OTHER THINGS TO CONSIDER

- **RESTROOMS.** Only 2 at a time. Physical distancing to be maintained if there is a waiting line.
- **SANITATION.** A sanitation crew will sanitize the sanctuary, fellowship hall, and restrooms regularly.
- **SUNDAY SCHOOL.** We encourage you to meet at home as a family.
- **BIBLE CLASS.** We will have Bible class with no more than 5 to a table in the Fellowship Hall. For those who choose to remain at home, we will also link up with them at 9:15 a.m. through Zoom.
- **SNACKS AND DRINKS.** Food will not be served during Phase 2 or 3.

!! PLEASE NOTE !!

- Those in the **HIGH-RISK** category *should* consider remaining home at this time.
- Those who are exhibiting any **SYMPTOMS** (cough, flu-like symptoms, fever of 100.4 or above) or who are in the same household with someone who is exhibiting symptoms **MUST** remain home.
