There will be a voters meeting for the next fiscal year's budget. The meeting is scheduled for Sunday, September 26, after second service.

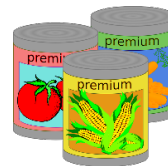
CONGREGATIONAL KUDOS CORNER

EVERYONE HAS A STORY

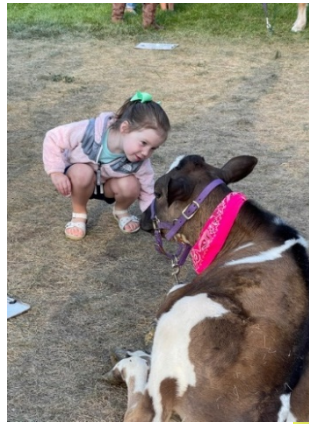

If you are planning on attending in person at either the 8:00 a.m. or 10:30 a.m. service, you will need to wear a mask. If you don't have one, one will be provided.

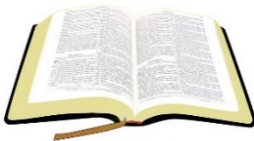
WOMEN'S BIBLE STUDY
