If you plan to attend in person either at the 8:00 a.m. or 10:30 a.m. service, we encourage you to wear a mask. If you don't have one, one will be provided.

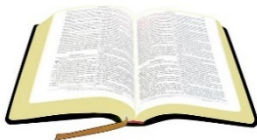
WOMEN'S BIBLE STUDY
