## WOMEN'S BIBLE STUDY

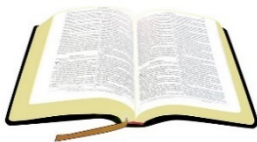
Women's Bible study will meet on Monday, November 29, at 10:00 a.m. Masks are encouraged, and we will be meeting at Edith Haber's home.
