The South Hill Beautiful Savior Blood Drive will be on February 12, Saturday, from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. Donors are scheduled every 15 minutes. Please be a donor. Help someone by sharing your blood—free donuts for donors.

Did you know inclement weather and seasonal illnesses can significantly reduce blood drives and donor availability with little notice, but patients need blood every day of the year?

- It's not just snow and cold, but high winds and heavy rain can also cause road closures and blood drive cancellations.
- Donated blood must continually be on hand before each patient need arises.
- Blood donations are being distributed to hospitals as quickly as donations are collected.

The need is particularly urgent for type O and platelet donations.

- Type O is often needed in emergency situations as well as for routine lifesaving surgeries, cancer treatment and more.
- Type O-negative blood can be transfused to patients of any blood type and is what doctors reach for in trauma situations when there isn't time to determine a patient's blood type.
- Type O-positive can help more than 80% of the population who have Rh-positive blood.
