Outcome of June 2024 Voters' Assembly Meeting

The Sep 2023 Voters' Meeting minutes and the Feb 2024 Special Voters' Meeting minutes were approved.

By a vote of 60-14 the attending members passed the recommended Bylaws changes. Next step for the Council is to forward these to the District for review and approval. Once approval is received, the Bylaws changes will be official and become our new governing guidance, processes and procedures.

The Mission Funding recommendations were also accepted, and this enables progress on the FY2024-2025 budget we will examine and approve at the Sep 2024 Voters' Assembly Meeting.

Dick Kunze provided a snapshot assessment of the financial statuses of BSLC and the ELC. Outlook for the remainder of FY2023-2024 looks positive for both.

Pastor Herbert presented a brief overview of his activities since the last update.

As mentioned, Sep 2024 is our next Voters' Assembly Meeting. The FY2024-2025 budget will be the primary agenda item. As soon as available, but NLT two weeks prior to the scheduled meeting, budget information will be published for the Congregation to review.
