Your involvement can make a difference. Serving not only helps our church but also provides a fulfilling experience for you.

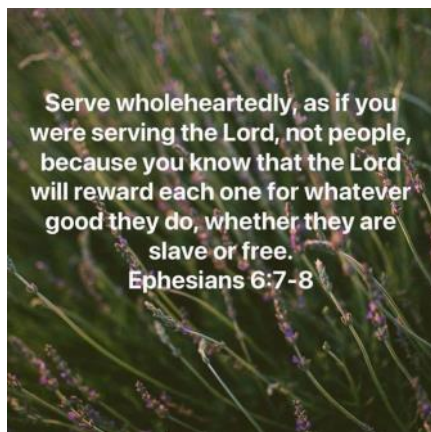
There are several opportunities to serve in our church: Church Council, member of a board, or committee roles. Another way is volunteering for our serving groups.
